NOTES:

National Park fees and Conservation Levy:

USD \$ 100 per person per **night** will be added to the confirmation invoice

Fishing permit:

USD \$ 30 per person per **day** will be billed in camp to clients directly at the conclusion of their stay dependent on days fished.

Minimum length of stay:

- Please note that the minimum length of stay is 2 nights.

Rates include:

- Accommodation, all meals, all local beverages, 2 activities per day, laundry, Wi-Fi and transfers from/to both Kulefu and Jeki airstrips.

*No privately purchased alcohol may be brought onto the property for consumption.



Rates exclude:

- Transfers outside the park, nightly National Park fees, daily fishing permit and items of a personal nature (i.e. purchases and gratuity).

Booking and Payment Policy:

- Guests affected due to the Coronavirus pandemic may postpone their booking to 2024 season, at the same 2023 rates.
- Should the dates of the amended booking fall in a season where higher rates are applicable, the traveler shall be responsible for payment of the difference between the season rate of the original booking and the season rate of the new booking.
- Bookings may be amended free of charge up to any time within 2023 season subject to availability.

Provisional Bookings:

- All provisional bookings quoted will be held for a period of 30 days, unless another period is expressly referred to on the relevant quote.
- Once provisional bookings are confirmed, payment terms and conditions will automatically apply.

Confirmation:

- Should a booking be moved to new dates in 2024 and confirmed, our standard cancellation and payment terms will apply.
- A 20% deposit/commitment fee is required upon confirmation of the bookings.

Deposits & Payments:

- All deposit/full payments are refundable for cancellations due to Coronavirus pandemic.
- We do not take payments for accommodation at camp and therefore all payments for accommodation must be made prior to arrival.
- Please note that that all payments prior to arrival should be settled free of exchange rate fees, bank and credit card charges.
- Any deposits already paid, for a booking that has subsequently been postponed will be retained by Amanzi Camp and applied towards the new dates booked.
- Final payment on the original invoice must be received by Amanzi Camp 30 days prior to travel. No guest may travel unless we have received full payment.

Cancellations:

- Cancellation between 60 and 31 days prior to date of travel will incur a 50% fee of total cost of the invoice.
- Cancellation within 30 – 0 days prior to date of travel will incur a 100% fee of total cost of the invoice.
- No shows, will incur a 100% cancellation fee of the invoice.

Travel and Medical insurance:

- Fully comprehensive travel insurance is recommended, covering for personal effects, personal accident, medical and emergency travel expenses, as well as cancellation and curtailment - as bookings will be subject to cancellation penalties as detailed above.



Visa and Passports:

- Visa requirements should be checked prior to departure. Some nationalities require a visa, these are obtainable upon entry to Zambia.

Child Policy:

For FIT bookings:

- Children 12+ are welcome

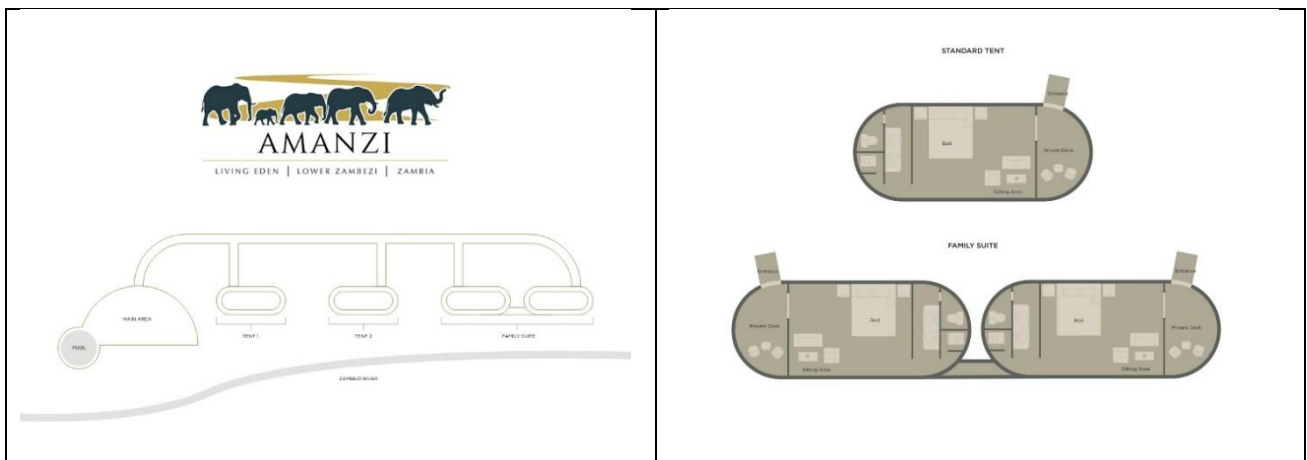
For Exclusive Use bookings:

- Children of all ages are welcome, but must be under strict parental or adult guest supervision for the duration of their stay.
- Children may participate in activities with the consent of their parents and the head guide. (Guided bush walks are not permitted for children under the age of 12 years)

General Camp Information.

Room Configuration:

- Amanzi Camp has 4 suites and 1 pilot | guide room in total.
- There are 2 stand-alone tented suites and 1 two-bedroom family suite. The 2 suites making up the two-bedroom family suite are identical to the stand-alone tented suites regarding interior layout.



Activities include:

Game drives, walking safaris, boat trips, fishing, and birding.

Seasonality:

December, January, February, & March:

- During rainy season Amanzi Camp is closed.

April, May:

- Most of the rain fades away, leaving a landscape that is green and lush, with clear skies and pleasantly mild temperatures.



June, July and August:

- The nights are generally much cooler, but the days are clear and warm. Make sure you bring warm clothes to wrap up in the early mornings and evenings, as some nights get very cold.

September, October and November

- These days are clear and warm to very hot. Every now and then a cooler day can be experienced, so make sure you bring warm clothes to wrap up in the early mornings and evenings, just as a precaution.

In camp payments:

- In camp payments for anything excluded from the general rates can be settled in cash (USD) or by credit card. Credit card payments attract an additional 5% of the total in camp bill to be settled.

Tipping:

This is at your own discretion and is not expected, but a rough guide is \$10 per person per night for the general camp staff, and a further \$10 per person per night for your safari or fishing guide if you are happy with the effort and service provided.

Medical:

Malaria does exist in Zambia; therefore, it is recommended that you take malaria prophylaxis. There are many different types of preventatives, so it is important to seek advice from your physician on the best anti-malarial pills to take.

It is also a good idea to take your own personal medical kit, although Amanzi Camp has a comprehensive emergency medical kit and most medicines.

Scheduled & Charter flights

- Our reservations office will gladly assist you in booking flights to and from Amanzi within Zambia.
- Meet and greet services can be booked at a fee of USD \$16 pp at Lusaka and Livingstone Airports.
- Luggage Allowance 20kg in soft duffle bags and 5 kg hand luggage per person.
- Extra luggage shall be charged at seat rate.

Note: \$16 departure plus \$5 safety taxes per person to be paid at all International Airports. A meet and greet service is recommended for smooth travel transitions at international airports and can be purchased at the time of booking for USD 16 per person.



Accessibility:

- The quickest and most convenient access to Amanzi, is by light aircraft charter transfer flights from Lusaka to Kulefu airstrip. The flight takes 35 minutes and the complementary open vehicle transfer from Kulefu to Amanzi Camp takes 15 minutes.
- Scheduled light aircraft transfers operated by ProFlight are also available daily from Lusaka to Jeki airstrip and Jeki Airstrip to Lusaka. The flight takes 35 minutes and the complementary open vehicle transfer from Jeki airstrip to Amanzi Camp takes 1h30 minutes.
- Livingstone to Jeki and Jeki to Mfuwe (South Luangwa) direct air transfer connections are available over select months of the open season dates. Please enquire with reservations for more information on this.
- Boat transfers are also available from Royal Airstrip or any Zambian camp upstream within the park, game management area or as far as the border town of Chirundu (Gwabi Lodge) (Prices on request).
